Please use the diary below to guide your prayers for our life as a church and God's work in our community.

- Mon 29th** Continue to remember The Barretts from 4H and the people they work with in Hungary. Pray for health, protection, grace and blessing on them both.
- Tue 30th** Remember the children and their families in Kidz Club, Saturdads and Come and See. Pray that God will put His power behind the sacrifice of time and effort made by all those involved.
- Wed 31st** Pray for Hebron Church as we head towards the New Year. Pray for Angela as she starts her second year with us and for the Elders, Deacons and Trustees that they will be equipped, strengthened and blessed by God in all they do. Pray for continued unity amongst us all.
- Thu 1st** We pray for God's Spirit to lead us each step of this New Year. We ask that God will guide our decisions and turn our hearts to deeply desire Him above all else. We ask that God will open doors needing to be opened and close the ones needing to be shut tight.
